### ObliqSound releases *The ObliqSound Remixes* – March 10, 2003

Right in step with **ObliqSound**'s motto of "*Music Without Boundaries*," the label introduces *The ObliqSound Remixes* – a dance remix project.

**ObliqSound** commissioned a handful of prominent DJs/Producers to put their personal signatures on tracks taken from the label's premiere release – *The ObliqSound Sampler*. *The ObliqSound Remixes* features the likes of **Chris Brann** (**Ananda Project/Wamdue/p'taah**), **Freaks** (**Luke Solomon/Justin Harris – Classic Records**), **Riton** (aka **Henry Smithson – Grand Central UK**), **Wai Wan** (**Earthproject**), and German newcomer **Paul Tietze** (who has remixed **Renovation Unlimited's "Summertime"**).

The diversity of the source material makes *The ObliqSound Remixes* a rather innovative project. For instance, when commissioning "**Summertime**," **ObliqSound** surprisingly found that many people did not want to touch a Jazz standard. But **Riton** and **Tietze** have done justice to the work – each on opposite ends of the spectrum in regards to style and interpretation. Provocative, but yet keeping the integrity of the original **Gershwin** song in much the same manner that **Renovation Unlimited** has done.

**Wai Wan** remixed "**Mendiani**" written by **Flügelschlag!** member and composer/arranger **Gert Wilden Jr.** This edgy three piano ensemble from Germany will release their debut album **Winter 2003** launching the labels *Instrumental Series*. **Wilden's "Mendiani"** combines a Senegalese Choir with the piano trio giving **Wai Wan** ample material to create a remix that is progressive.

*The ObliqSound Remixes* also introduces the premiere release of the label's *Vocal Series* by New Zealand born Maori artist **Tama Waipara**. **Chris Brann** and **Freaks** have remixed **Tama Waipara's "Felise"** (inspired by 19<sup>th</sup> Century poet **A.C. Swinburne**). His premiere album will be released on **ObliqSound** March 2003.

*The ObliqSound Remixes* will also be available on 12" vinyl and the label is working to service select DJs in Europe and in the U.S.

**ObliqSound** has also refined its design synthesis. It's new manufacturer, **Herzog & IDEX**, has created a superb prototype for the label's releases that improve the company's design standards for CD packaging dramatically.
